COURSE DESCRIPTION: Final Touch Training is designed to prepare therapists to work with people at the end of life. Rather than a specific technique, we focus on adapting what you already know to meet the needs of the dying. Encompassing both skill set and mindset, this workshop will support massage therapists and other professionals who wish to expand their practice to include hospice and palliative care and/or desire to support loved ones as they face the end of life.
